Gloucester, MA – Guided by the light of the fantastic firefly as their inspiration, 16 Boston Sculptors Gallery artists will exhibit site-specific sculptural works on the grounds of the Manship Artists Residency + Studios (MARS) in Gloucester, MA. On display September 25 through October 24, *Boston Sculptors: ALight on MARS* embraces a diverse range of media, featuring glowing, twinkling, light-emitting works populating the lawns, afloat in the quarry waters, and amidst the trees.

Paul Manship, celebrated sculptor of the Prometheus Fountain in New York City's Rockefeller Center, established his summer residence and studio here amid Cape Ann's granite quarries. Fascinated by the fireflies that lit up the meadows at night, Manship named this enchanting property "Starfield" in their honor, delighting in his ability to walk through the virtual field of stars they created.

As part of their Firefly Initiative, an ongoing effort to draw attention to the magic and wonder of these luminescent beetles, MARS invited Boston Sculptors artists to create a "festival of light." The exhibition was juried and curated by Belinda Rathbone and Cynthia Roth. Supported by The Manship Artists' Prometheus Circle of donors and with grants from Applied Materials and New England Biolabs Foundations, as well as by the Local Cultural Councils of Gloucester, Rockport, Hamilton-Wenham and Beverly; programs of and funded by the Massachusetts Cultural Council.
