(Boston, MA) Claudia Olds Goldie's first solo exhibition at Boston Sculptors Gallery will be on view January 1 through February 5, 2017. Her figurative ceramic work investigates the complex contradictions of body, mind, and perception, examining how living and aging changes the psyche and the physical body. Focusing on the lives and bodies of women, she examines nature's design and the forces that inevitably alter it.

A member of Boston Sculptors Gallery since 2015, Olds Goldie is also represented by Frederick Holmes Gallery in Seattle, and Santa Fe Clay Gallery in New Mexico. She is the recipient of numerous awards from organizations including the Society of Arts and Crafts, Watershed Center for Ceramic Arts, and the Vermont Studio Center. Her work was featured in the 2013 National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts (NCECA) Biennial in Houston and the Sculpture Objects Functional Art and Design (SOFA) Fair in Chicago. She teaches ceramics at Harvard University and Dexter Southfield School in Brookline.

*Skin Deep* runs concurrently with *Embodied Energy* by Nancy Selvage. The exhibitions feature two author readings. *Writers Resist: Where Things Begin to Happen* on January 15<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm, with Margot Livesey, Julie Lekstrom Himes, and Margaret Zamos-Monteith. *River Weep: Poets Speak* on January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 2 pm, with Sammy Greenspan, Deborah Schwartz, and Lee Sharkey.

Nancy Selvage presents *Embodied Energy: An Artists' Forum* considering the sustainability of various art practices and materials, January 29<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm. Boston Sculptors Gallery's new music series *Second Sunday Sound and Sculpture* presents Christos Koulendrous on January 8<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm.
